Tomales Bay State Park General Plan Public Meeting Scheduled for May 6 at Point Reyes Station

POINT REYES -- California State Parks will hold a public meeting regarding the Tomales Bay State Park general plan from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. on Tuesday, May 6 at the Dance Palace, 503 B Street (Corner of 5th and B streets) in Point Reyes Station. The Dance Palace is accessible.

The May 6 meeting will be conducted in an "open house" format in order to facilitate personal interaction between the public and the park staff. The presentation will include planning maps, information tables, and input opportunities arranged according to planning topics.

Park staff will be available to discuss and take comments regarding planning goals and process, Tomales Bay State Park's *Summary of Park Resources*, and planning issues, possibilities and concerns.

The California Department of Parks and Recreation is developing a long-range general plan for Tomales Bay State Park, which will be used to guide the park's future management, development and public use.
